Sub:- P.S.-T & A Department – Sanction of (2) Notional increments to the teachers who are completed two years of service after 1.4.2009 – certain clarification sought for - Information submitted – Reg.

Ref:- 1) Govt. Memo No.3440/SE.Ser.I.2/2012, dt.21.2.2012.

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With reference to Govt. Memo. under reference cited, I wish to submit that, the Govt. have requested the Commissioner & Director of School Education, AP Hyd to furnish information keeping in view of the clarifications issued in Govt. Memo No.8663/SE.Ser.I/2010, dt.1.7.2010 and specific remarks on the clarification sought for by the DTA as to whether the teachers who were appointed through District Selection Committee after 01.04.2009 are also eligible for sanction of (2) notional increments on completion of two years apprenticeship period and if so the date from which monitory benefit shall be allowed.

In this connection, I wish to submit that, the Govt. in their Memo No.8663/Ser.I/2010, dt.1.7.2010 has issued orders for payment of arrears of teachers on completion of the two years apprenticeship period and on assigning the pay scale from time to time, ie., the teachers those who were recruited from DSC 1994 to DSC-2006.

In this connection, I wish to state that, in the present case, the teachers were appointed through DSC after 1.4.2009 and their pay is to be regulated on completion of two (2) years of period on or after 1.4.2011 duly sanctioning two notional increments. Hence the date of monetary benefit will be the date of assigning the scale duly sanctioning two notional increments.
